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1. Introduction

1.1. Introduction

The Sirocco basic / Sirocco deluxe Shower Stretcher is a medical device for caring for and washing clients in an ergonomically responsible manner. Comfort is the primary consideration for both the client and the caregiver.

The Sirocco basic / Sirocco deluxe Shower Stretcher comprises a base frame and a height-adjustable supporting surface with a soft mattress. The stretcher can be mounted on the wall with the head end on either the left or right side. The Sirocco deluxe also has a back adjustment. There are no essential performances.



The frame of the Sirocco basic / Sirocco deluxe has an antibacterial coating. The coating contains silver ions. Antibacterial coating based on silver ions prevents dangerous micro-organisms such as bacteria, fungi and algae multiply and spread. The effectiveness was confirmed in several tests. Germs were demonstrably reduced in a short time to 99.99%. The coating only affects bacteria that are found on the surface and not on airborne micro-organisms. The coating protects users or others from disease-causing bacteria, germs, viruses or other harmful organisms. On a dirty surface, the coating loses its antibacterial properties. So proper cleaning and disinfection is still a must.

The Sirocco basic / Sirocco deluxe is multi-functional in use and corresponds to the use of other devices such as beds, wheelchairs and shower chairs, hoisting equipment and sliders.

The expected technical life of the Sirocco basic / Sirocco deluxe is 10 years, assuming it is cleaned daily and regularly maintained according to the maintenance schedule supplied (*See chapter 5. Cleaning and maintenance*).

De Sirocco basic / Sirocco deluxe is a class 1 medical device with CE-marking. This marking corresponds with regulation MDR (EU) 2017/745. The Sirocco basic / Sirocco deluxe has been tested for electro-magnetic radiation according to the IEC 60601-1-2.

1.2. Safety

A failure to comply with the following safety points and the further definitions in these instructions for use could lead to hazardous working situations. Please read carefully before use.

Use

• Before you start work with the Sirocco basic / Sirocco deluxe, check that there has been a fully loaded battery placed in the controlbox.

- The Sirocco basic / Sirocco deluxe switches to standby after a few seconds, when not in use.
- Notify the client before moving the Sirocco basic / Sirocco deluxe.
- Be aware of obstacles and persons in the immediately vicinity when moving or adjusting the stretcher.
- Make sure that the client always places his / her arms / legs inside the mattress in order to avoid anything getting jammed.
- Always close the siderails before moving upwards/downwards the Sirocco basic / Sirocco deluxe with client.
- It is not permitted to load the Sirocco basic / Sirocco deluxe with more than 227 kg / 500 lbs. The Sirocco basic with fixed height can be loaded with a maximum of 150 kg.
- The Sirocco basic / Sirocco deluxe is only suitable for moving and caring for one person.
- Use only original parts, supplied by Lopital. The use of non-original parts can cause dangers.
- The use of components (chargers, cables, actuators, batteries, etc.) that have not been supplied by Lopital may result in increased emissions or decreased immunity of the Sirocco basic / Sirocco deluxe.
- Use the Sirocco basic / Sirocco deluxe in a clean and tidy working environment.
- Charge battery box in a well-ventilated, dry space.
- Swimming pool locations are not considered to be 'normal conditions' and will substantially shorten the lifespan of certain components.
- The Sirocco basic / Sirocco deluxe may only be used indoors.
- Don't touch the batteryterminals and the client at the same time.
- Portable and mobile RF communication equipment can affect medical devices. Portable RF communications equipment (including peripherals such as antenna cables and external antennas) should be used no closer than 30 cm (12 inches) to any part of the Sirocco deluxe / Sirocco basic including cables specified by the manufacturer. Otherwise, degradation of the performance of this equipment could result.
- Medical electrical devices involve special EMC precautions and must be used as per the EMC information outlined in the instructions for use.
- The emissions characteristics of the Sirocco basic / Sirocco deluxe electric make it suitable for use in industrial areas and hospitals (CISPR 11 class A). If it is used in a residential environment (for which CISPR 11 class B is normally required) this equipment might not offer adequate protection to radio-frequency communication services. The user might need to take mitigation measures, such as relocating or re-orienting the equipment.
- The stretcher must not be used adjacent to or stacked on other products. However, should that be necessitated, it must be checked whether the stretcher functions normally in this configuration too.

Maintenance

• If the charger or cable become damaged, they must be replaced.

- If the mattress is damaged, replace the mattress for hygiene reasons.
- It is recommended to replace the mattress after 5 years for hygiene reasons.
- The Sirocco basic / Sirocco deluxe must be serviced and inspected at least once a year.
- Servicing and maintenance of the Sirocco basic / Sirocco deluxe may only be carried out by
 persons with a technical background, who have experience in servicing and maintaining similar
 products.
- If the Sirocco basic / Sirocco deluxe is adjusted, appropriate inspection must be conducted to ensure continued safe use of the shower stretcher.
- Constructive components of the Sirocco basic / Sirocco deluxe may only be replaced by suitably authorised personnel.
- The Sirocco basic / Sirocco deluxe shall not be serviced or maintained while in use with a client.
- If erroneous use, transport, an accident or improper maintenance leads to deformation of the Sirocco basic / Sirocco deluxe, it may no longer be used and you must contact the supplier or manufacturer.

The Sirocco basic / Sirocco deluxe may only be operated by persons who have experience working with the target group and have followed the Instruction / trainings video's on the website of Lopital.

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The Sirocco basic / Sirocco deluxe has been developed and produced for use in a professional care environment.



Making changes to the construction could affect the safety of the Sirocco basic / Sirocco deluxe. This will also lead to Lopital's liability and warranty conditions being invalidated. As a result, the Sirocco basic / Sirocco deluxe will no longer comply with the regulation MDR (EU) 2017/745 for medical devices.



If a serious incident occurs related to this medical device tht affects the caregiver or the client, it must be reported to Lopital or the distributor of the medical device.

1.3. Warranty

All Lopital products are supplied with a 5-year warranty, on construction and / or material faults, unless otherwise stated. In the event of varying warranty terms, the exact period will be indicated on your invoice; this also serves as the warranty itself. Components and batteries that are subject to wear and tear will not fall under warranty unless there are clear construction and / or material faults.

2. Use

The images below show the components of the Sirocco basic / Sirocco deluxe. The detachable parts of the stretcher are the mattress and the batterybox.

3. Operation

3.1. Side rail

- The Sirocco basic / Sirocco deluxe is equipped with aluminium side rails that can be collapsed so that sliding transfers can be carried out.
- The side rail is equipped with safeguards (1) so that the client cannot raise the side rails themselves (*See figure 1*).
- Before the side rail is collapsed downwards, the safeguard must be unlocked.
- Unlock the safeguard by using one hand to pull the protruding handle (1) and rotating the side rail with your other hand (2).
- With folded side rails, the caregiver can lean against the mattress in the middle to better care for the patient.
- Turn the side rail upwards again to close the side rail. The side rail locks automatically (See figure 2).
- The side rail can be placed in 2 positions, wide and narrow. When you fold the side rail upwards, the side rail is first locked in the wide position (*See figure 3*). By pulling the handle of the lock (*See figure 2*) you can move the side rail further back to its narrow position.

3.2. Moving upwards / downwards (Sirocco basic & Sirocco deluxe)

Moving upwards

- The stretcher is moved upwards by pressing the control button with the arrow pointing upwards. The stretcher will then move upwards evenly (1) (*See figure 4*).
- You can stop the movement whenever you like by taking your finger off the button.
- During the upward movement, maintain contact with the client.
- If the remote control is not being used, it can be hung on the side rail.
- Ensure that the curly cable on the operating device does not get jammed.

Moving downwards

- Move the stretcher downwards by pressing the button that shows a 'down' arrow the stretcher will immediately move downwards (2) (*See figure 4*).
- You can stop the movement whenever you like by taking your finger off the button.
- During the downward movement, maintain contact with the client.

When the hand control is lost or defect, the shower stretcher can be adjusted in height by pressing the buttons on the control box (*See figure 5*).



Before moving the stretcher, check to ensure there are no persons or objects in the immediately vicinity of the stretcher.

3.3. Backrest adjustment

Electrick back adjustment (Sirocco deluxe)

The stepless electric back adjustment is operated by pressing the buttons on the hand control (*See figure 7*). Release the button when the backrest is in the correct position.

3.4. Waterdrainage

Water is drained away from the Sirocco basic / Sirocco deluxe via a drainage hose. To do this, remove the hose from the recess (1) and route it to the lowest possible drainage point *(See figure 8)*. Always click the hose into the recess of the lying plate, in connection with leaking and dripping.

3.5. Changing battery (Sirocco basic & Sirocco deluxe)

The Sirocco basic / Sirocco deluxe is an electrically adjustable high-low stretcher and works on a battery.

- The battery is located at the head-end of the stretcher (*See figure 9*).
- There is a battery indication on the hand control (*See figure 10*).
- Charge the battery on the chargerstation (See figure 11).
- In order to remove the battery, use one hand to unlock the catch (1) on the battery, then slide the battery forward (*See figure 9*).
- To install the fully charged battery, it must first be positioned next to the electronic housing and then clicked into the holder.
- You can better insert and remove the battery when the back adjustment is in the folded position (Only Sirocco deluxe).

Make sure that the Sirocco basic / Sirocco deluxe is always ready for use by having a fully charged reserve battery on standby. If this is not the case, lift the client from the stretcher with a patient hoist or manually with at least 2 persons.



When the battery box is fully charged, it will be able to perform the high / low movement in combination with the back adjustment approximately 45 times.



After 4/5 years it is recommended to replace the battery box.



Only use batteries that are supplied with the Sirocco basic / Sirocco deluxe. The batterybox that is used for the Sirocco basic / Sirocco deluxe is the 'Ti-motion BAT-4259-002' 2.9 Ah, 24 V.

3.6. Charging battery (Sirocco basic & Sirocco deluxe)

• Place the battery to be charged on the battery chargestation (See figure 12).

The charger that is used for the Sirocco basic / Sirocco deluxe is the 'Ti-motion TBC2'.



Charge batteries in a well-ventilated, dry space.

4. Safety functions

4.1. Emergency stop (Sirocco basic & Sirocco deluxe)

On the side of the head-end, there is an emergency stop. Operate must be stopped immediately. Once the emergency stop is pressed, the electronic controls will stop working. The emergency stop interrupts all power.

Operation may be continued once the situation is stable again. Turn the emergency stop a quarter turn to unlock it again (*See figure 13*).

First check to ensure the hazard has been removed or the problem has been resolved, before resetting the emergency stop button.

If the button is activated, no leds will light up on the hand control.

If the handcontrol stop working and the stretcher is in a raised position, it can be lowered using the emergency lowering button. This button is located on the controlbox (*See figure 14*).

First check that the stretcher is not in sleep mode!

• Press the emergency lowering button (See figure 14).

The stretcher will now return to the lowest position (make sure no persons or objects are under the stretcher). Take the client from the stretcher and make sure the device is not used until it has been repaired. Place the stretcher in a safe place and indicate that it is out of order.

5. Cleaning and maintenance

The Sirocco basic / Sirocco deluxe must be cleaned after every use, with water and regular household cleaning agents. Do not use any abrasive or other aggressive cleaning products. If necessary, the mattress can be disinfected with a solution of 70% ethanol or propanol.

For the best and most efficient cleaning of the mattress and the lying surface, the mattress can be lifted up and removed. Dry the plate on which the mattress lies.

Maintenance and repairs to the Sirocco basic / Sirroco deluxe may only be carried out by authorised personnel.

If you take care of disposal of the product yourself, you must take account of the fact that batteries and chargers must be disposed of as small chemical waste.

8.4. Length adjustment

The Sirocco basic / Sirocco deluxe is equipped with a length adjustment. For example, the shower stretcher can easily be extended or shortened.



If you want to adjust the length of your Sirocco basic / Sirocco deluxe, we recommend that you have this done by Lopital or by persons qualified by Lopital.

Each length has his own mattress:

Sirocco basic:

- Mattress 186 cm, article number: 6720 0005
- Mattress 206 cm, article number: 6720 0015

Sirocco deluxe:

- Mattress 186 cm, article number: 6720 0010
- Mattress 206 cm, article number: 6720 0020

Sirocco basic fixed height:

- Mattress 186 cm, article number: 6720 0005
- Mattress 206 cm, article number: 6720 0015

To adjust the length of the shower stretcher, the mattress must be removed. Then dismantle the lying plate (*See figure 15*). The length adjustment is now visible. Loosen the bolts of the length adjustment (1) (*See figure 16*). Slide the adjustable frame out or in of the base frame and fix it at the desired length (2). Then mount the lying plate and place the correct mattress on the lying plates.

8.5. Replacement of parts

The following components can be replaced by service personnel in event of damages.

- Mattress
- Drainage hose
- Lying plates



If other parts needs to be replaced, this must be done by authorised personnel. Contact your dealer or contact Lopital.

Mattress

- 1. To remove the mattress you have to loosen the push buttons.
- You can lift the mattress. Please note, it can occur that the mattress is clamped to the drainage point. Lift the mattress at this point carefully.
- 3. Place the new mattress and fasten the push buttons.

Drainage hose

- 1. Unscrew the drainage hose.
- 2. Place the new drainage hose.

Lying plates

- 1. To replace the lying plates, you have to detach the mattress and the drainagehose.
- 2. Unscrew the 4 screws from the lyingplates.
- 3. Remove the lying plates.
- 4. Place the new lying plates on the frame and fix it with the 4 screws.
- 5. Mount the drainage hose.
- 6. Place the mattrass on the lying plates.

10. Relation with other supports

Hoist / Ceiling hoists

The Sirocco basic / Sirocco deluxe has been designed for optimal use in combination with a patient lift. The shower stretcher has a lying surface height of 45 to 95 cm.

Wheelchair

In lower settings of 45-55 cm / 17.7-21.7 inch, clients can be transferred from shower stretcher to wheelchair and vice versa. An ideal device to be used during this operation is the small slide sheet (and possibly a sliding board).
